REASON OF CHANGE:
Infineon TPM SLB9635 TT 1.2 with firmware 1.02 has been announced end-of-life (EOL) and will no longer be available.

DESCRIPTION OF CHANGE:
BCM will add the Infineon TPM SLB9635 TT 1.2 with firmware 3.19 to the approved vendor list (AVL) in the bill of materials (BOM) for the above impacted products.

IMPACT OF CHANGE AND RECOMMENDED ACTION:
BCM has tested the impact of this change.

- For customers that do not use the TPM feature but do use a Microsoft® plug-n-play O/S with a pre-existing software image:** During the first system boot-up only, there will be momentary message flash in Windows Status Bar indicating that the systems detects the new TPM hardware. This is a one-time event and will not happen on any subsequent system starts or restarts. After this initial start the system will operate normally. This change has been thoroughly evaluated to ensure that there are no quality, reliability, functional, driver or BIOS implications to our customers. BCM is not recommending customer that do not use the TPM feature to undergo additional qualifications of these changes on the above motherboards.
- For customers that do use the TPM feature:** Regardless of what operating system you use, BCM recommends you contact your BCM representative to special order a motherboard with the new Infineon part to test the new TPM hardware to ensure it is compatible with your system or software and their respective TPM functionalities.
